Sunday, December 23

- Daily Bible Reading John 13-15

- Daily Bible Reading John 19-21
- Merry Christmas <u>Praise God</u> for sending His Son Jesus to be born! Spend time thanking God for the many blessings, but most of all, His Son!
- **Missions** Pray for the ministry of Jonathan and Sarah Weber (Belgian Evangelical Mission—Belgium).
